



Naresuan University Announcement

Subject: Research Ethics Training for Graduate Students, B.E. 2567 (2024)

To ensure that graduate students recognize the significance of conducting research grounded in appropriate ethical standards and academic principles, and to ensure adherence to the ethical guidelines for researchers as prescribed by the National Research Council of Thailand (NRCT), which will contribute to the production of high-quality, internationally recognized research from the university, Naresuan University, by virtue of the authority vested in Section 20, Section 21, and Section 37 of the Naresuan University Act, B.E. 2533 (1990), in conjunction with Article 5 of the Naresuan University Regulations on Graduate Studies, B.E. 2565 (2022), and pursuant to the resolution of the Academic Council in Meeting No. 5/2567, held on 7 May 2024, hereby mandates the implementation of research ethics training for graduate students, B.E. 2567 (2024) as follows:

Article 1: This announcement shall be referred to as the "Naresuan University Announcement on Research Ethics Training for Graduate Students, B.E. 2567 (2024).

Article 2: This announcement shall apply to research ethics training for students who began their studies in the 2023 academic year onwards and to students enrolled in new programs and revised programs pursuant to the Announcement of the Commission on Higher Education Standards on Graduate Program Standards, B.E. 2565 (2022) onwards.

Article 3: In this announcement,

"Research Ethics Training" refers to the research ethics training organized by the Graduate School, or training conducted by other institutions, or enrollment in courses that cover content and duration consistent with the research ethics training criteria specified by Naresuan University Graduate School.

Article 4: The Naresuan University Graduate School shall organize research ethics training for graduate students every semester. Students may express their interest in participating in the Research Ethics Training starting from their first year of graduate studies onwards.

Article 5: All students enrolled in Master's degree programs under Plan 1 and Doctoral degree programs under Plan 1 and Plan 2 must complete the Research Ethics Training before they become eligible to take their Thesis Proposal Examination, as required by their respective programs.

In cases where students have already registered for courses or completed training programs that cover the content of research ethics, they may submit a request to the Dean of the Naresuan University Graduate School to use the results of that coursework or training in lieu of attending the research ethics training. The request will be considered for approval by the Graduate School Standing Committee.

Article 6: The President of Naresuan University shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with this announcement. In the event of any issues regarding its implementation, the President shall have the authority to resolve the issues and make decisions. The President's decision shall be deemed final and irrevocable.
