

## Naresuan University Announcement

Subject: Guidelines for Conducting Theses, B.E. 2566 (2023), No. 2

With reference to the Naresuan University Announcement on Guidelines for Conducting Theses, B.E. 2566 (2023), dated 22 August 2023,

In order to ensure that the development of theses by graduate students at Naresuan University proceeds smoothly, with quality, and in accordance with the standards set forth by the Announcement of the Commission on Higher Education Standards on Graduate Programs Standards, B.E. 2565 (2022), and pursuant to Sections 20, 21, and 37 of the Naresuan University Act, B.E. 2533 (1990), and Clause 30(4) of the Naresuan University Regulations on Graduate Studies, B.E. 2565 (2022), in conjunction with the resolution of the Academic Council at Meeting No. 10/2567, held on 1 October 2024, the guidelines for conducting theses are hereby established as follows:

Article 1: This announcement shall be titled "Naresuan University Announcement on Guidelines for Conducting Theses, B.E. 2566 (2023), No. 2."

Article 2: This announcement shall apply to students who enroll from the academic year 2023 onward, and to students studying in new or revised programs as per the Announcement of the Commission on Higher Education Standards on Graduate Programs Standards, B.E. 2565 (2022).

Article 3: The provisions of Article 10(2) of the Naresuan University Announcement on Guidelines for Conducting Theses, B.E. 2566 (2023), dated 22 August 2023, are hereby repealed and shall be replaced with the following text:

"Article 10: Request for Thesis Examination

(2) The department/program/academic chair shall submit the names of the thesis examination committee, which have been approved by the dean of the faculty/college responsible for the program, to the Graduate School for the appointment of the thesis examination committee at least 15 days prior to the scheduled examination date. The request for the thesis examination must be made at least 90 days after the announcement of approval for the graduate student to proceed with research in accordance with the thesis proposal."

Article 4: Any matters not specified in this announcement shall be governed by the

provisions of the Naresuan University Announcement on Guidelines for Conducting Theses, B.E. 2566

(2023), dated 22 August 2023.

Article 5: "The President of Naresuan University shall be responsible for the

enforcement of this announcement. If any issues arise regarding the implementation and compliance

with this announcement, the President shall have the authority to resolve the issues. The President's

decision shall be considered final."
